Group Size: 1-2 Students

Learning Objective: Examine why relations between the United States and the Greater Middle East have turned sour.

Activity: Create a news story that teaches the class about a significant event that has occurred in the Greater Middle East region within the past 20 years.

Possible Topics: Iraq and North Africa in the News

- Desert Storm/The First Gulf War
- Saddam Hussein
- The history of al-Qaeda
- The Arab Spring (in Egypt, Yemen, Libya, etc.)
- The attack on the American Embassy at Benghazi
- The civil war in Syria and the chemical weapons attack
- The War of Terror (Afghanistan or Iraq)
- The real Blackhawk Down: American in Somalia
- The real Captain Philips: Somali Pirates in the Indian Ocean
- Israel's relations with the rest of the Greater Middle East
